



Warranty Procedure

Roofing Contractors are responsible for submitting the following:

Pre-Installation Review

Prior to ordering materials, complete the PIN form. A roof diagram is necessary so that valve placement can be determined.

Intent to Warranty*

Prior to job start, complete the correct "Intent to Warranty" form. This form **must** include the signature of the building owner or designate, and a detailed roof drawing using the area provided to show the following:

- a) Roof size (all dimensions)
- b) All protrusions and drains
- c) Edge and flashing details
- d) 2001 Company application technique used
- e) Type of membrane used (this information must be provided)

*If you are interested in a Wind Warranty Rider, or any other rider please notate on back of the intent.

Completion of Work Statement

Once the roof is ready for the final inspection, complete, sign and return the "Completion of Work Statement".

Warranty Cost Program

Calculate warranty cost according to warranty years using our "Warranty Cost" price sheet. Note that a minimum charge applies to **all** warranties.

Valid Contractor's Agreement and Credit Agreement

Must be returned to 2001 Company and processed, prior to warranty issuance.

Contractor Corrections Punchlist

Must be completed in conjunction with a 2001 Company representative, signed and returned to 2001 Company verifying that all corrections have been made as specified.

Submit above forms along with warranty fee check payable to 2001 Company and mail to:

If sending check separately, always note the building name on the check for faster processing.

NOTE: Inspections must be scheduled through the home office and must be performed by a 2001 Company Inspector. All paperwork/checks must be submitted prior to inspection. If in doubt, please call our office at 800-537-7663. Any incomplete or improper warranty forms will cause a delay in the issuance of the warranty.
