Overview: PVC flashing membrane is a heat-weldable roofing membrane formulated for direct exposure to the weather and is produced with an integral fiberglass mat reinforcement for dimensional stability. PVC flashing membrane is used to flash roof penetrations. PVC flashing membrane is produced in various widths and lengths.

Composition: PVC flashing membrane is a high-quality product containing ultraviolet light stabilizers, flame retardant, and reinforcement. It has a unique lacquer coating applied to the top of the membrane to resist staining from airborne dirt and pollutants. The standard color of the weathering surface of PVC flashing membrane is off-white and the underside color is dark gray.

Features: The manufacturing process causes PVC flashing membrane to have no built-in stress at time of production and to have a fully-encapsulated reinforcement with no risk of delamination or water-wicking. PVC flashing membrane is thicker than many competitive products which can improve weldability and service life. PVC flashing membrane is available in the following thicknesses: 48 mil (1.2 mm) and 60 mil (1.5 mm). PVC flashing membrane is highly dimensionally stable making it ideal for adhered flashing applications at walls, terminations and penetrations.

Packaging: PVC flashing membrane rolls are provided individually and are sealed for shipping.

Installation: PVC flashing membrane is installed by 2001 Inc. Authorized Applicators on walls, curbs and certain other penetrations using 2001 Inc. adhesives. The seams are then heat welded together by trained operators using 2001 Inc.'s hot-air welding equipment.
